This year's guild challenge will be to create a "Star Spangled Banner". You may interpret this any way that makes sense to you. You may use a line from the song itself or any interpretation of the phrase, either literal or figurative. The requirements are measurements between 20" x 20" and 30" x 30", any shape is acceptable as long as it meets the size limits. It must also meet the generally accepted definition of a quilt - 2 layers of fabric, with a layer of batting between. Register using the general Show registration form, checking the box that indicates a challenge quilt. Please include how you interpreted the theme in your description. If you use a line from the song, please make sure to include it.

Please try and think outside the box - it is a pretty wide open theme if you give it some thought.
